RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Newspapers of Record

FOR the purpose of designating the County's newspapers of record pursuant to Section 1008 of the County Charter.

WHEREAS, Section 1008 of the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland, provides that the County Council shall designate three newspapers of record for the publication of official County notices; the designated newspapers of record shall have a combined circulation of not less than three percent of the population of the County; and at least four

weeks public notice shall be given prior to any change in the newspapers of record; and

WHEREAS, based upon a population of 729,268, three percent of the population of the County is 21,878;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the following newspapers with a combined circulation of 46,688 paid subscribers are hereby designated County newspapers of record:

Prince George's Journal	38,755
Prince George's Post	4,370
Enquirer Gazette	3,563

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the change of designation shall be effective four weeks following publication of the change of designation.
