BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of assigning certain existing classes of work to the bargaining unit represented
4 by the Prince George's Correctional Officers' Association, Inc. (PGCOA) (Civilian Unit).

5 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the County Charter and
6 Section 16-125(a) of the County Code, has recommended to the County Council amendments to
7 the Classification Plan for Prince George's County with respect to the classes of work described
8 within Section 1 of this bill, in accordance with the Certification of Representation issued by the
9 Prince George's County Public Employee Relations Board (PERB) in Case No.

10 16 390 00467 02 for positions in the bargaining unit represented by the Prince George's
11 Correctional Officers' Association, Inc. (PGCOA) (Civilian Unit) now, therefore,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
13 Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County, Maryland be and the same is
14 hereby amended as follow:

6211Q Crew Supervisor I, Q-12
(\$27,509 - \$54,376)

6212Q Crew Supervisor II, Q-15
(\$31,625 - \$62,669)

6213Q Crew Supervisor III, Q-17
(\$34,724 - \$68,911)

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law and shall be retroactively effective to July 1, 2007.
