Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Bailey, Del Giudice, Estepp, and Maloney)

Staff gave an overview of the resolution. Council Member Hendershot, the resolution's sponsor, indicated to the Committee that he proposed this resolution at the request of the Mayor of the Town of University Park in order to approve the amendments to the Town's Code concerning fences. Mr. Hendershot informed the Committee that there is no citizen opposition to the proposed amendments to the Town Code.

The Office of Law has determined that the resolution is in proper legislative form. The Executive Branch took no position on the resolution.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT
(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

Article 28, Section 8-112.1 of the Annotated Code of Maryland requires that certain municipal ordinances regulating residential parking, fences, and outdoor storage be approved by the District Council before the ordinance becomes effective. This is a resolution to approve amendments to the Town of University Park's code. The resolution will approve the enactment of Amended Legislative Resolution 96-13, amending Article 1, Chapter 4 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town concerning fences.
