BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Tax Differential Task Force

3 For the purpose of establishing a four-year term of office for appointees to the Annual Tax
4 Differential Task Force.

5 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

6 SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION.

7 Section 10-186.02

8 The Prince George's County Code

9 (2019 Edition; 2022 Supplement).

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
11 Maryland, that Section 10-186.02 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same hereby
12 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

13 **SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION.**

14 **DIVISION 6. MUNICIPAL TAX DIFFERENTIAL**

15 **Sec. 10-186.02. Annual Review.**

17 (a) The Tax Differential Task Force shall mean an appointed body for the purpose of
18 conducting an annual review and the Task Force shall be comprised of the following
19 representatives:

21 (1) One Member from the Office of the County Executive;

23 (2) One Member from the County Council;

2 (3) One Member from the Office of Management & Budget;

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4 (4) Two Members designated by Prince George's County Municipal Association;

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6 (5) Two Members from unincorporated areas of the County and appointed by the Chair of
7 the County Council.

8
9 (b) Each member shall be appointed for a term of four years.

10
11 (c) At the end of a term a member shall continue to serve until a successor is appointed.

12
13 [(b)](d) The Tax Differential Task Force shall conduct an annual review of the Tax Differential
14 program and rules adopted by the Director for its implementation, including methods of
15 ensuring adequate public awareness. This review shall be completed on or before July
16 31 of each year. Appropriate recommendations shall be submitted by the Task Force to
17 the County Executive, as may be necessary.

19 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby
20 declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,
21 sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of
22 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining
23 words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this
24 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such
25 invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,
26 or section.

27 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
28 calendar days after it becomes law.
