Sec. 10-193. County Income	Tax.	
Pursuant to Tax-General	Article, Section 10-106, Annotated Code of Maryland, as	
amended, each County shall es	stablish a County income tax equal to at least twenty percent (20%)	
and not more than sixty percer	at (60%) of the State income tax for an individual. The County	
income tax is established in an	amount equal to <u>fifty-eight percent (58%)</u> [sixty percent (60%)]	
of the Maryland State income tax for an individual for each of the residents of Prince George's

1	County effective January 1, [1995] 2000. The rate shall be fifty-six percent (56%), effective
2	January 1, 2001; fifty-four percent (54%), effective January 1, 2002; and fifty-two percent,
3	effective January 1, 2003. The rate shall be set at fifty percent (50%) of the Maryland State
4	income tax for an individual effective January 1, 2004.
5	SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the Clerk of the Council shall notify the
6	Comptroller of the rate change and the effective date of the rate change set by this Act on or
7	before July 1, 1999.
8	SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
9	calendar days after it becomes law.
