1 AN ACT concerning

2 Supplementary Appropriations

3 For the purpose of appropriating additional revenue from available and uncommitted fund
 4 balance to the Drug Enforcement and Education Special Revenue Fund, to provide funds for
 5 costs that were not anticipated in the Approved Fiscal Year 2001-2002 Budget for the Drug
 6 Enforcement and Education Special Revenue Fund.

7 WHEREAS, CB-32-2001, as amended, adopted and enacted the Annual Budget and
 8 Appropriation Ordinance of Prince George's County for Fiscal Year 2001-2002, which sets forth
 9 the amount of appropriations and revenue estimates, said appropriation and revenue estimates to
 10 be adjusted as hereinafter set forth; and

11 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 819 of the Charter for Prince George's County, Maryland,
 12 the County Council may, upon recommendation of the County Executive, make additional or
 13 supplementary appropriations from revenue received from anticipated sources but in excess of
 14 budget estimates therefore, from revenue received from sources not anticipated in the budget for
 15 the current fiscal year and from any prior year available and uncommitted fund balance, provided
 16 that the Director of Finance shall first certify in writing that such funds are available for such
 17 appropriation; and

18 WHEREAS, certain Special Revenue Funds of the County government require additional
 19 appropriations as provided herein, and certain additional revenues have been identified; and

20 WHEREAS, the County Executive has duly recommended that the supplementary

1 appropriations be made; and

2 WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified in writing that fund balance is available
3 for such supplementary appropriations; now, therefore

4 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
5 Maryland, that the following adjustments to revenue estimates for the Fiscal Year 2001-2002 for
6 Other Funds as expressed in CB-32-2001, as amended, are made:
