RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Roads and Sidewalks - Design and Construction Standards and Requirements

For the purpose of incorporating urban street design standards and specifications as consistent with Plan Prince George's 2035 for Regional Transit Districts and Local Centers in Prince George's County, striving to balance the needs of all users that are business-friendly, walkable, bike-able and transit friendly; generally regarding design and construction standards and urban street designs, and

WHEREAS, the new Urban Street Design Standards are intended for use in designing of new and retrofit streets in the eight Regional Transit Districts and 26 Local Centers, as established by Plan Prince George's 2035 that have the necessary transit and transportation infrastructure to support future growth as mixed use centers; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Street Design Standards ("Exhibit A") sets standards and criteria for urban street standards for use in the Prince George's Regional Transit Districts and Local Centers as set forth in Exhibit A as attached; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works and Transportation ("DPW&T") established a work group composed of staff from various departments to develop the new urban standards, called the Steering Committee and included representatives from (1) Office of the County Executive; (2) DPW&T; (3) Department of Permitting Inspection and Enforcement ("DPIE"); (4) Department of Environment; (5) Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Steering Committee met frequently to discuss the development of the standards, the standards were shared with a wider community for feedback and included consent

from (1) County Fire/EMS; (2) various utility companies; (3) Maryland Building Industry Association; (4) American Consulting Engineers Community; (5) Coalition for Smarter Growth; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the proposed standards as set forth in Exhibit A, further work has been identified by DPW&T to make these standards feasible and includes updating existing standards and developing further details such as driveways, separated bike lanes, location of street furniture, bike parking and also additional guidance and support to DPIE in reviewing the site development application and assignment of streets into the new street typologies; and

WHEREAS, the County Council and the County Executive have determined, based upon the finding and determinations set forth herein, that it is in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the County that the County Council and the County Executive approve the Urban Street Design Standards as set forth in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, upon approval by the County Council, a forthcoming bill shall be brought to the Council requesting amendments to the Prince George's County Code Subtitle 23, Roads and Sidewalks, to incorporate the Urban Street Design Standards into the Specifications and Standards for Roadways and Bridges of the Department of Public Works and Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Urban Street Design Standards be approved as comprehensive road design and construction standards for the Regional Transit Districts and Local Centers.
