Pursuant to Title 3 §3-1002 of the Education Article of the Maryland Code, it is my pleasure to recommend the appointment of Ms. Chaundrai Jackson-Saunders to serve on the Prince George's County Board of Education.

Ms. Jackson-Saunders is a nationally recognized public education leader and governance executive with more than three decades of experience advancing student achievement, equity, and institutional accountability across large, urban school systems. She served for 35 years with the District of Columbia Public Schools, providing system-level leadership and policy guidance in special education, student support services, family engagement, and regulatory compliance, ensuring adherence to federal and state mandates and strengthening outcomes for students and schools. Most recently, as Chief Operating Officer of Interdynamics, Inc., she provided executive oversight of a Prince George's County-based organization delivering school-based mental health and educational support services to Prince George's County Public Schools, directing fiscal management, operational strategy, workforce supervision, and compliance within a regulated public education environment. Her experience reflects strong stewardship of public resources, sound governance, and a consistent commitment to safe, supportive learning environments.

Ms. Jackson-Saunders also brings extensive board and fiduciary leadership experience, having served as a School Board Member for the Archdiocese of Washington Board of Education, an Advisory Board Member for the Child Protection and Advocacy Board, and currently as a Trustee of the Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority National Education Fund, where she provides strategic and financial oversight for national scholarship initiatives. In 2020, she was named National School Psychologist of the Year by the National Association of School Psychologists, the profession's highest honor, recognizing her leadership and impact on public education nationwide. She holds a Bachelor of Science in Psychology from the University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown, a Master of


Education in Educational Psychology from Howard University, and a Certificate of Advanced Graduate Studies in School Psychology and is a Nationally Certified School Psychologist.
