RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Fiscal Year 2025 Federal and State Transportation Grant Application Authorization For the purpose of authorizing the Director of the Prince George's County Department of Public Works and Transportation (DPW&T) to file applications for Fiscal Year 2025 to include, but not be limited to, those with the Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) and its' offices and modal administrations, including the Maryland Transit Administration (MTA), Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) and the Maryland Highway Safety Office (MSHO); the United States Department of Homeland Security (USDHS); the United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) and its' offices and modal administrations including the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA); the United States Department of Energy (DOE); the United States Protection Agency (EPA) and Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (MWCOG).

WHEREAS the Maryland Transit Administration (MTA) is the designated recipient in Maryland for grants under the Federal Transit Act; and

WHEREAS Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (MWCOG) is the designated recipient for the Enhanced Mobility Program and the Transportation Land-Use Connections Program grant; and

WHEREAS the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law grants under the Federal Transit Act; and WHEREAS the United States Department of Homeland Security (USDHS) is the designated recipient for the Transit Security Grant Program under the Federal Transit Act; and WHEREAS, the Administrator of the Maryland Transit Administration, the Administrator

1 of Maryland Highway Safety Office, the Administrator of Maryland State Highway 2 Administration, the Executive Director of the Metropolitan Council of Governments, and the 3 Secretary of Homeland Security are authorized to make grants to counties and local governments 4 for mass transportation programs and/or projects, respectively; and 5 WHEREAS an application for financial assistance imposes certain obligations upon the 6 applicant, which includes a local share of the costs for certain projects and/or programs; and 7 WHEREAS, the USDOT, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights 8 Act of 1964, requires an application for assistance under the Federal Transit Act to give 9 assurance that it will comply with the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the United 10 States Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's 12 County, Maryland, that the filing of the aforesaid applications for Fiscal Year 2025 be endorsed. 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution shall be sent to each of the 14 aforementioned entities, MDOT, MTA, SHA, MSHO, USDOT, FTA, FHWA, DHS, DOE, EPA 15 and MWCOG.
