BILL

AN ACT concerning

The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

FOR the purpose of adding and restructuring class titles and grades for certain classes of work.

WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has, in order to provide better governmental services, recommended to the County Council amendments to the Classification Plan for Prince George's County with respect to certain classes of work described within Section 1 of this bill, recognized by the County to provide better governmental services.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County, be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that employees in those classes of work enumerated in Section 3 of this Bill, shall, on the effective date of this Act, be placed at their respective new pay grades and shall have their salary rates adjusted to

the new minimum or by ten percent (10%), whichever is greater.

SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall become effective forty-five (45) calendar days after the date it becomes law.
