<u>CR-75-2004 – A RESOLUTION CONCERNING A MASTER PLAN AND</u> CONCURRENT SECTIONAL MAP AMENDMENT (SMA) FOR

SUBREGION I for the purpose of initiating a new master plan for Subregion I (Planning Areas 60, 61, 62 and 64) and amendment the 2002 Approved Prince George's County General Plan to establish development policies consistent with the intent of the 2002 General Plan recommendations for the US 1 Corridor and possible future Konterra Regional Center. The goals of the master plan are to enhance the quality and character of the community, encourage quality economic development, preserve and protect environmentally sensitive and scenic land, and make efficient use of existing and proposed county infrastructure and investment for the Subregion I area.
