RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

The formation of an agricultural district pursuant to the Maryland Agricultural Land
Preservation Program

FOR the purpose of recommending that the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation
Foundation approve the petition of John M. Walton, Sr. to establish an agricultural district.

WHEREAS, a petition filed by John M. Walton, Sr. requested the establishment of an
agricultural preservation district for approximately 107 acres of land on the south side of
Woodyard Road, 1000 feet west of Rosaryville Road, bounded on the east by Piscataway
Creek, on the south by Resurrection Cemetery, and on the west by several single- family
dwellings on lots of approximately two acres, as generally shown on the attached location
map; and

WHEREAS, the petition was referred to the Prince George's Planning Board and the
Prince George's County Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board for review and
recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Planning Board found that establishment of the
proposed agricultural district is compatible with existing and approved County plans and
recommended approval of the petition and establishment of the district; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board

found that the Walton property met the qualifying criteria for productivity, size, and location as set by the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation, and recommended establishment of the agricultural district; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council held a public hearing on the petition on April 16, 1996.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the 107.44 acre tract described in the agricultural district petition filed by John M. Walton, Sr., is recommended to the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation for approval; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution, copies of the petition, and copies of the letters from the Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board and the Prince George's County Planning Board, be forwarded by the Clerk of the Council to the County Executive for his consideration and, upon his approval, transmittal to the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation for appropriate action.
