RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The Revenue Authority of Prince George's County Fiscal Year 2017

3 Operating Budget and Capital Improvement Program

4 For the purpose of approving the Capital Improvement Program of the Revenue Authority of
5 Prince George's County for Fiscal Years 2017-2022, prepared pursuant to the authority contained
6 in Subtitle 21A of the Prince George's County Code and providing comments on the proposed
7 Operating Budget of the Authority for Fiscal Year 2017.

8 WHEREAS, Section 21A-119 of the Prince George's County Code provides that the
9 Revenue Authority of Prince George's County may propose one or more projects for inclusion in
10 the Authority's Capital Improvement Program and that the County Executive shall transmit to the
11 County Council for its approval by resolution or ordinance any such project approved by the
12 County Executive; and

13 WHEREAS, the Capital Improvement Program for the Revenue Authority includes one
14 renovation parking project, the New Carrollton Public Parking Garage (WG900123) project and
15 one Suitland Project (WM900812), for which a copy of the project descriptions are attached
16 hereto as Attachment 1; and

17 WHEREAS, the Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 2017 equals Eighteen Million and Five
18 Hundred dollars (\$18,500,000); and

19 WHEREAS, Section 21A-118 of the Prince George's County Code provides that if the
20 proposed operating budget of the Authority includes any item to be funded from payments to be
21 received from the County that the anticipated receipts shall be identified for each item and a copy
22 of the proposed budget shall be transmitted by the Authority to the County Executive and the

1 County Council for their review and comment; and

2 WHEREAS, the Authority has forwarded its proposed operating budget to the County
3 Executive and the County Council for review and comment, as shown in Attachment 2.

4 SECTION 1. BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George’s
5 County, Maryland, that subject to and in accordance with the authority of the Charter of Prince
6 George’s County and pursuant to Subtitle 21A of the Prince George’s County Code, the Capital
7 Improvement Program for Fiscal Years 2017-2022 of the Revenue Authority of Prince George’s
8 County, as submitted by the County Executive to the County Council, a copy of which is
9 attached hereto as Attachment 1 and incorporated herein by reference as though it was set forth
10 fully herein, is hereby authorized, approved, and adopted.

11 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council has reviewed the
12 proposed Operating Budget, Fiscal Year 2017, of the Revenue Authority of Prince George’s
13 County and concurs with the proposed Operating Budget in the Revenue Authority as reflected
14 in Attachment 2.
