EMERGENCY BILL

AN EMERGENCY ACT concerning

Collective Bargaining Agreement - Fraternal Order
of Police, Lodge #89, Inc.

FOR the purpose of approving the labor agreement by and between Prince George's County and Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #89, Inc., to provide for wage increases and certain other terms and conditions of employment for personnel classifications certified by the Prince George's County Public Employee Relations Board.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

SUBTITLE 16. PERSONNEL.

Section 16-233(f)(2),

The Prince George's County Code

(1987 Edition, 1988 Supplement).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the
County Council of Prince Georg
e's County, Maryland, that Section 16-233(f)(2) of the Prince
George's County Code be and the same is hereby repealed and

reenacted with the following amendments:

SUBTITLE 16. PERSONNEL.

DIVISION 19. COLLECTIVE BARGAINING.

Sec. 16-233. General.

(f) The following collective bargaining agreements are hereby adopted and approved:

(2) Declaration of Approval - Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #89, Inc.

The County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, having fully considered the labor agreement concluded between Prince George's County and Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #89, Inc., on [September 2, 1987] February 7, 1990, hereby approves said agreement in accordance with the provisions of Section 13A-109 of the Prince George's County Code.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that an emergency is hereby declared to exist affecting the health, safety, or welfare of the citizens of Prince George's County, Maryland, said emergency being the obligation to implement the labor agreement in order to provide the benefits of such agreement to employees and the County with the least possible delay.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on the date it becomes law and that the provisions of the contract shall be retroactively effective to the date specified in the Agreement.

Adopted this 20th day of March, 1990, by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the full County Council.
