RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Authorizing Specific Law Enforcement Duties for the Office of the Sheriff of Prince George's
3 County

4 For the purpose of approving specific law enforcement duties for the Prince George's County
5 Office of the Sheriff to collaborate on responding to domestic violence calls for service in Prince
6 George's County Police Districts III and VIII in accordance with Section 2-330 of the Courts and
7 Judicial Proceedings Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.

8 WHEREAS, Section 2-330(h)(1) and (2) of the Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article,
9 Annotated Code of Maryland, requires that the County governing body approve, by Resolution,
10 specific law enforcement duties for the Office of the Sheriff of Prince George's County; and

11 WHEREAS, Section 2-330(h)(2)(ii) states that the specific law enforcement duties
12 authorized shall be enumerated in a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") entered into by
13 the Prince George's County Police Department ("Police Department") and the Office of the
14 Sheriff of Prince George's County ("Office of the Sheriff");

15 WHEREAS, the Council reviewed the MOU between the Police Department and the Office
16 of the Sheriff, set forth in Attachment A and incorporated as if set forth fully herein;

17 WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends the approval of the specific law
18 enforcement duties enumerated in the MOU, which is set forth in Attachment A; and

19 WHEREAS, the Council finds that the approval of the specific law enforcement duties
20 enumerated in the MOU, which is set forth as Attachment A, is in the public interest.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
22 County, Maryland, that the specific law enforcement duties for the Office of the Sheriff of Prince

1 George’s County, enumerated in the Memorandum of Understanding between the Police
2 Department and the Office of the Sheriff, set forth in Attachment A, attached hereto and made a
3 part hereof, that were submitted by the County Executive pursuant to Section 2-330 of the Courts
4 and Judicial Proceedings Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, be and the same is hereby
5 ADOPTED.

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Police Department and the Office of the Sheriff are
7 hereby authorized to make such necessary modifications, adjustments, corrections, or any other
8 changes as may be necessary, to finalize the subject Memorandum of Understanding in any
9 manner deemed necessary or proper but not altering its substance.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution requires a public hearing; the Clerk of
11 the County Council shall be directed to set and give notice of a public hearing on this Resolution
12 in accordance with prescriptions of law.
