BILL

AN ACT concerning

The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

For the purpose of assigning certain existing classes of work to the nonsupervisory bargaining unit represented by Council 67, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME), AFL-CIO and its affiliated Local 3279.

WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has recommended to the County Council amendments to the Classification Plan for Prince George's County with respect to the classes of work described within Section 1 of this bill, in accordance with the Clarification of Unit/Amendment of Certification of Representation issued by the Prince George's County Public Employee Relations Board in Case Number 16 390 00238 94 for positions in the nonsupervisory bargaining unit represented by AFSCME; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

1301C Public Service Aide I, C-02
(\$12,682 - \$20,602)

1302C Public Service Aide II, C-04
(\$13,982 - \$22,714)

6719C Weighmaster I, C-12
(\$20,656 - \$33,560)

6720C Weighmaster II, C-14
(\$22,774 - \$36,999)

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
