This legislation will adopt the 2008 Water and Sewer Plan and the 2008 Water and Sewer Category Maps, and revise a fee schedule for administering Water and Sewer Plan amendments, and the purchase of maps and related materials.

Environment Article, Title 9, Subtitle 5, of the Maryland Annotated Code, sets procedures for amendments and revisions to the Water and Sewer Plan. At least 30 days prior to the public hearing on the revision or amendment, the County Council must submit a copy of the Resolution to the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission and the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission for their recommendations.
