WHEREAS	S, the District Council adopted CR-10-2003 to initiate a new Bowie and Vicinity
Master Plan and	Sectional Map Amendment (Planning Areas 71A, 71B, 74A, and 74B) to
implement the re	ecommendations of the 2002 General Plan; and
WHEREAS	S, Goals, Concepts and Guidelines approved September 30, 2003 specify the
issues, public par	rticipation program and schedule; and
WHEREAS	S, this new master plan and sectional map amendment will replace the 1991
Bowie-Collingto	n-Mitchellville and Vicinity Master Plan; and
WHEREAS	S, the Prince George's County Council, by unanimous vote, has rejected the
intrusion of the I	intercounty Connector (A-44) and all of its extensions including (A-58) as well
as the Public Tra	insportation Facility (PT-1) into the planning area; and
WHEREAS	S, the District Council desires that the Bowie and Vicinity Master Plan and
sectional map an	nendment introduce improved land use tools and be implemented as soon as
possible.	
NOW, THE	EREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
County, Marylan	nd, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington
Regional District	t in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the new Bowie and Vicinity Master
Plan not include	the Intercounty Connector, any of its extensions or PT-1; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the schedule for development of the Bowie and Vicinity Master Plan be expedited as much as possible, with the period for adoption and approval of the master plan and its SMA be accomplished by January 2006; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that needed land-use tools be considered as part of this master plan and the sectional map amendment, including Transfer or Sale of Development Rights, redevelopment of existing underused commercial areas, elimination of ineffective isolated commercial uses, advantageous mixed-uses, implementable cluster developments establishing base building densities not increased by the presence of unbuildable acreage, agricultural-use preservation, and other tools beneficial for Prince George's County and its citizens.
