BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

On May 30, 1996, the Planning Board voted to support a resolution which initiates the Functional Master Plan for Schools. The District Council included in the M-NCPPC FY 1997 work program an item to update the Functional Master Plan for Schools on an expedited timetable. The Functional Master Plan for School Facilities will revise and update the student enrollment projections, locate future school sites based on current planning criteria and projected needs, and provide a tool to allocate scarce capital and operating funds. When adopted and approved, the Functional Master Plan

for Schools will amend all area master plans. This resolution will initiate the planning process necessary to begin the Functional Master Plan and the public participation process required under Part 13 of the Zoning Ordinance.
