Committee Vote, Favorable, 5-0, (In favor: Committee Members Peters, Harrington, Hendershot, Knotts and Shapiro.)

This resolution will amend the Salary Plan in Salary Schedule R for Emergency Response Technicians in the Fire/EMS Department represented by the International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF), Local 1619, and reflects modifications of the two year collective bargaining agreement. (July 1, 2003 – June 30, 2005)

The fiscal impact on the County will be negative in the amount of \$1,461,828 (FY2004 - \$438,161 and FY2005 - \$1,023,667). The annualized cost for FY2006 is \$526,077. The total cost of the Agreement is \$1,987,906

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This is companion legislation to the bill to approve the collective bargaining agreement between Prince George's County, Maryland and the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 1619 (Emergency Response Technicians) for Fiscal Years 2004 and 2005. This resolution reflects modifications of the agreement. The estimated fiscal impact will be provided by the Office of Management and Budget.

The proposed salary plan amendments were submitted to the County Council by the County Executive on April 9, 2004. Pursuant to Section 903 of the Charter, if the Council fails to take final action on the proposed salary plan before June 8, 2004, the salary plan shall stand approved.
