3 For the purpose of requiring COVID-19 vaccinations of all child care facility and day care center

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
16 Maryland, that Section 5-126 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
17 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

18 SUBTITLE 5. BUSINESSES AND LICENSES.

19 DIVISION 3. CHILD CARE FACILITIES.

20 **Sec. 5-126. Health requirements for employees and children.**

1 (a) Health Regulations Affecting Staff.

2 * * * * *

3 (6) COVID-19 Vaccination. Staff members shall be fully vaccinated for the COVID-
4 19 virus and shall provide proof of such vaccination.

5 SECTION 2. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
6 Maryland, that Section 5-133 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
7 added:

8 **SUBTITLE 5. BUSINESSES AND LICENSES.**
9 **DIVISION 3A. DAY CARE.**

10 **Sec. 5-133. COVID-19 Vaccination Requirement.**

11 (a) Staff members of the day care facility shall be fully vaccinated for the COVID-19 virus
12 and shall provide proof of such vaccination.

13 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby
14 declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,
15 sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of
16 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining
17 words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this
18 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such
19 invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,
20 or section.

21 SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
22 calendar days after it becomes law.
