## RESOLUTION

## A RESOLUTION concerning

A Supplementary Appropriation and Transfer of Funds between Major

Categories of the Budget of the Board of Education FOR the purpose of providing a supplementary appropriation in the amount of \$2,210,000 from State, Federal and Board of Education revenues which were not included in the budget for the current fiscal year and transferring funds between Major Categories for program modifications.

WHEREAS, Council Bill 54-1990 adopted and enacted the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance of Prince George's County for Fiscal Year 1990-1991, which set forth the amount of revenues estimates, which estimates are to be adjusted as hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, under the provision of Section 819 of the Charter for Prince George's County, Maryland, the Council, upon the recommendation of the County Executive, may, by Resolution, make

additional or supplementary appropriations from Federal, State or private grants which were not included in the budget for the current fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, under Section 5-105(c)(2) of the Education Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland approval of the County Council is required in order for the Board of Education to transfer funds between major categories; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has requested a supplementary appropriation in the amount of \$2,210,000 in order to preserve educational services and programs for all children in Prince George's County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has requested a transfer of funds between major categories in order to ensure the correct distribution of expenditures for actions taken by the school system in balancing its budget; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has duly recommended that the supplementary appropriation be made; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince
George's County, Maryland, that the following adjustments to revenue
estimates in the Fiscal Year 1990-91 Approved Current Expense Budget
as expressed in CB-54-1990 are revised by supplementary
appropriation as follows:
