Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 6-0-1 (In Favor: Council Members

Pemberton, Casula, Castaldi, Bell, Wilson and Wineland; abstaining: Council Member Mills)

Council staff explained to the Committee that CB-48-1990 incorporates the MPDU requirements established in CB-12-1990 and CB-14-1990 into the application process for preliminary and final plats of subdivision, and into the subdivision review process. It is effective July 1, 1990, as are the companion bills.

The Committee did not raise any issues, and there was no testimony presented regarding the legislation.
