LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

Potomac Electric Power operates a fossil fuel electrical generation facility at Chalk Point in the County. Co-location of a refuse incinerator at the site and the use of refuse-derived fuel in PEPCO's boilers provide an alternative to landfilling of municipal solid waste remaining after the removal of recyclable materials. Chalk Point is accessible by railroad. The resolution directs the County's Department of Environmental Resources to undertake a feasibility study of incineration in public utility facilities.
