##### PLANNING, ZONING & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

**Date 6/23/2004**

Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Dernoga, Dean, Exum, and Harrington)

This legislation removes restrictions on truck marshalling imposed by the enactment of CB13-2000 and CB-20-2000. CB-40-2004 is to allow settlement of pending federal litigation, Jemal's Fairfield Farms, LLC v. Prince George's County, et al. Civil Action No. RWT – 02-2881. A companion bill, CB-39-2004, was also presented to address the pending case.

The Office of Law reviewed CB-40-2004 and found it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

The Office of Audits and Investigations determined there should be no negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of enacting this legislation.
