For the purpose of providing the required approval to the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland ("DHCD") for the financing of the acquisition and development of the Newton Green Apartments, a senior rental project to be owned and operated by Newton Green, LLC a joint venture of Ingerman Affordable Housing, Inc. and Housing Initiative Partnership, Inc. (collectively referred to as the "Owner").

WHEREAS, there is a significant need for quality rental housing units in Prince George's County for seniors of low or limited income; and

WHEREAS, the Owner proposes to acquire and develop land and operate a rental housing development comprised of approximately 78 units, known as Newton Green Apartments located at 5300 Newton Street and 5501 Quincy Street in Landover Hills (the "Project") all or a portion of which will assist low to moderate income seniors; and

WHEREAS, DHCD, either directly or through DHCD's Community Development Administration ("CDA"), may provide some or all of the financing for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the applicable law and regulations of Title 4, Housing and Community Development Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland and Title 05 of the Code of Maryland Regulations requires approval of the Project and the Project financing by the County Council for Prince George's County and the County Executive; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive endorses and recommends approval for the Project and the Project financing as set forth on Attachment "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof.
