**ZONING BILL**

AN ORDINANCE concerning

Household Pets

FOR the purpose of defining "Household Pets".

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

Section 27-107.1,

The Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland,

being also

SUBTITLE 27. ZONING.

The Prince George's County Code

(1987 Edition).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that

part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 27-107.1 of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

**SUBTITLE 27. ZONING.**

**PART 2. GENERAL.**

**DIVISION 1. DEFINITIONS.**

**Sec. 27-107.1. Definitions.**

(a) Terms in the Zoning Ordinance are defined as follows:

(122) Hotel: A "Building" which contains six (6) or more "Guest Rooms", none of which have entrances from outside the "Building", and where (for compensation) temporary lodging is provided. A "Motel", "Fraternity or Sorority House", "Dormitory", "Tourist Home", "Rooming House", or "Boardinghouse" shall not be considered a "Hotel".

(122.1) Household Pet: The definition of "Pet" in Subtitle 3 shall serve to define "Household Pet" in this Subtitle.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) calendar days after the date of its adoption.
