COMMITTEE REPORT

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**

This bill is to adopt and approve the collective bargaining agreement with Deputy Sheriff's Association, Inc. (DSA) in accordance with Section 16-233(f) of the Personnel Law. The County and Deputy Sheriff's Association reopened their existing three-year labor agreement through fiscal year 1992 and negotiated a new collective bargaining agreement covering the period July 1, 1991 through June 30, 1993. The detail of the cost savings resulting from this agreement will be provided by the Office of Management and Budget.
