	RESOLUTION
A RESOLUTION concerning	
	The Revised Elderly Property Tax Credit
For the purpose of delaying the effective date of CB-007-2024 – The Revised Elderly Property	
Tax Credit, and to provide the necessary time to revise CB-007-2024 and enact legislation that	
clarifies the senior citizens eligibility for a senior tax credit.	
WHEREAS, or	a June 28, 2022, the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland
adopted CB-29-2022	2, which established a Property Tax Credit for Elderly Individuals; and
WHEREAS, on February 27, 2024, the County Council of Prince George's County,	
Maryland presented legislation (CB-007-2024) to revise the elderly tax credit to make it	
available to certain senior citizens exclusive of and separate and distinct from the Homestead and	
Maryland's Homeowner's Property Tax Credit; and	
WHEREAS, or	November 12, 2024, the County Council adopted CB-007-2024, with
amendments, after h	olding a public hearing; and
WHEREAS, after subsequent review and consultation with the Office of Finance, several	
provisions in CB-007-2024 must be clarified to identify the senior citizens eligible for a senior	
tax credit; and	
WHEREAS, prior to the enactment of CB-007-2024, by the enactment of CB-29-2022, the	
Office of Finance was provided unambiguous language as to the seniors eligible for a senior tax	
credit; and	
WHEREAS, a revised act is required to clarify the terms of the senior tax credit and to	
provide clear direction to the Office of Finance and to the public as to those seniors that are	

eligible for a tax credit; and

WHEREAS, as a result, on February 11, 2025, The County Council extended the effective date of CB-007-2024 to June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, due to the increased complexity of the task of clarifying the terms of the senior tax credit, the effective date of CB-007-2024 needs to be further extended; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1017(c) of the Prince George's County Charter, a resolution has the force and effect of law but of a temporary or administrative character.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that CB-007-2024 and CB-029-2022, shall be suspended until further amendment to CB-007-2024; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive, through the Council Chair, may submit proposed curative legislation to the Council for consideration; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect December 31, 2026, absent further legislative action by the County governing body.
