**REPORT:** Favorable 4-0: Council Members Burroughs, Franklin, Ivey, and Turner. Absent: Streeter.

The Prince George's County Council's Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee convened on September 8, 2022, to consider CB-083-2022. CB-083-2022 will approve the Collective Bargaining Agreement between Prince George's County, Maryland (the "County") and the International Association of Fire Fighters ("IAFF"), Local 1619, AFL-CIO (Fire Fighters, Paramedics, and Fire Fighter/Medics) covering Fiscal Years 2023 and 2024. Although the Agreement carries forward many of the terms and conditions of the County's previous labor agreement with the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 1619, AFL-CIO (Fire Fighters, Paramedics, and Fire Fighter/Medics), the new Agreement contains modifications listed for the Council in the enclosed ("Settlement Summary").

The Agreement provides merits and cost of living adjustments for FY'23 and FY'24 for employees covered by this Agreement.

The Office of Law reports CB-083-2022 to be in proper legislative form with no impediments to its enactment.

The Policy Group reports that enactment of CB-083-2022 will require additional expenditures of \$18 million over fiscal years 2023 and 2024.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council's Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee reported CB-083-2022 out favorably 4-0.
