#### DIVISION 1. T-D-O (TRANSIT DISTRICT OVERLAY) ZONE.

Subdivision 1. General.

### Sec. 27-548.09.01.01. Car Sharing in the Transit District Overlay Zone.

For development proposals within a Metro or light rail station that is existing, is funded for future construction, or has final design approval, parking requirements may be reduced based on development density for each parking space designated for a car-sharing vehicle by Memorandum of Understanding between a car sharing corporation or company and the development applicant. The reduction shall not exceed twenty (20%) percent of the total minimum required parking spaces for Transit District Overlay Zones. The reduction shall be determined during the development review process and in accordance with the below chart:

Location	The maximum number of parking spaces that may be reduced per each designated car-share
Buildings within ¼ mile of a Metro or Light Rail	8
Station	
Buildings within ½ mile from a Metro Station or Light	6
Rail Station	

DIVISION 3. D-D-O (DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT OVERLAY) ZONE.

For development proposals within a Metro or light rail station that is existing, is funded for

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future construction, or has final design approval, parking requirements may be reduced based on
development density for each parking space designated for a car-sharing vehicle by

Memorandum of Understanding between a car sharing corporation or company and the
development applicant. The reduction shall not exceed fifteen (15%) percent of the total
minimum required parking spaces for Development District Overlay Zones. The reduction shall
be determined during the development review process and in accordance with the below chart:
