BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This bill will extend amend Section 24-1901 of the County Subdivision Regulations to provide an additional two (2) years for access to review of subdivision applications under the prior Regulations. If enacted, this bill extends the time for access to the prior Regulations, absent further action of the County, to April 1, 2026.
