LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

FISCAL POLICY AND GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS COMMITTEE DATE: 11/25/91

Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0 (Council Members Wineland, Del Giudice, MacKinnon and Mills).

This resolution will approve a Federal Program Supplemental Appropriation in the amount of \$191,134. These funds will provide for the creation and operation of a Financial Investigations Unit (FINVEST) within the Police Department's Narcotics Enforcement Division. The FINVEST unit will be used to develop investigative leads to identify drug distribution by obtaining financial evidence to support drug charges and to disrupt the financial support network of drug dealers. The grant has been received from the Bureau of Justice and was effective on November 1, 1991. The County is providing \$71,534 for in-kind funding.

The Office of Finance has certified in writing that the funds are available.

The Office of Law has reviewed this resolution and finds it to be in proper legislative form.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CR-122-1991.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT
