WHEREAS, At	ticle III, Section 321 of the Charter for Prince George's County provides
that the County Cour	cil shall compile, codify, adopt, and publish a Code of the laws of the
County in effect at su	ch times at intervals not greater than four years; and
WHEREAS, the	Zoning Ordinance for Prince George's County, Maryland, being also
Subtitle 27 of the Pri	nce George's County Code, was last published as the 2011 Edition; now,
therefore,	
SECTION 1. B	E IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
Maryland, sitting as t	ne District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional
District in Prince Geo	orge's County, Maryland, that the 2015 Edition of the Zoning Ordinance of

Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, be and the same is hereby compiled, codified, adopted, and published.

- (a) On and after the effective date of this Ordinance, Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, as set out in the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, 2015 Edition, together with any current Supplement that may be issued, shall be, with respect to the matter set fort h therein:
- (1) Conclusive evidence of the text of Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, together with all amendments enacted or adopted on or before November 30, 2011; and
- (2) Prima facie evidence of all Zoning text amendment enacted after November 30, 2015.
- (b) Supplements containing any changes in, or additions to, the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, 2015 Edition, shall be published annually.
- SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the 2015 Edition of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, shall take effect on the effective date of this Ordinance. The master copy of the 2015 Edition of the Zoning Ordinance shall be authenticated by the Council's Legislative Officers and delivered as a public record to the Clerk of the Council. The Clerk shall maintain that master copy together with any supplements thereto. A copy of the 2015 Edition of the Zoning Ordinance for Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, shall be made available in the Office of the Clerk of the Council for public use during regular business hours.

1	SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the general penalty provision provided in
2	Section 1-123 of the Prince George's County Code shall apply to every offense or violation
3	made unlawful by the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also
4	Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, unless a specific penalty therefor is otherwise
5	provided by law.
6	SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect on the
7	date it becomes law.
