PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 5/8/95

Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Estepp, Gourdine, Maloney and Russell).

This bill will restrict the discharge of firearms within the limits of the County where the projectiles traverse the property of another person without obtaining consent and endanger their life, limb or property.

The Police Department, Fraternal Order of Police (FOP), Prince George's Chamber of Commerce and City of Bowie support this legislation.

Page 2

The legislation was amended as follows:

A. On page 3:

- 1. Delete line 1 and insert "in the defense of a person's life; and"
- 2. Line 3 insert paragraph (d)
- 3. Lines 10, 14 and 18, delete (d) (e) and (f) and insert (e) (f) and (g) respectively.

The fiscal impact on the County may be positive related to any penalties collected for violation of this Section of the County Code.
