**BILL**

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Amending the Administrative Leave Hours Allowed for County Employees who Volunteer in  
3 Schools

4 For the purpose of increasing the administrative leave hours allowed for County employees who  
5 volunteer in schools from twenty (20) to thirty (30) hours to support the schools in the areas of  
6 remediation and recovery activities particularly in reading and mathematics.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,  
13 Maryland, that Section 16-222 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby  
14 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

15 SUBTITLE 16. PERSONNEL.

16 DIVISION 17. LEAVE.

17 **Sec. 16-222. Administrative leave.**

18 (a) Administrative leave may be granted to any full-time or part-time employee by the  
19 employee's appointing authority for any one (1) of the following reasons:

(13) For the purpose of volunteering in the Prince George's County public and private schools not to exceed [twenty (20)] thirty (30) hours per year to support the schools in the areas of remediation and recovery activities particularly in reading and mathematics;

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
