#### **Public Safety and Fiscal Management**

**Date 9/23/2008**

Committee Report: Favorable as amended, 4-0 (In favor: Councilmembers Knotts, Dean, Exum and Turner.)

This bill will amend the County's Classification Plan by abolishing and creating various classes of work within the Information Technology (IT) Classification. A classification study was conducted by the Office of Information Technology and Communications (OITC) to establish classifications that are compatible with the duties and responsibilities that are compatible to neighboring jurisdictions. The proposed classification changes will be useful to all County agencies that have staff which provide services within the Information Technology field.

The Office of Law has reviewed the bill and finds it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its enactment.

The legislation was amended by replacing the old salary range numbers with new salary range numbers to reflect the changes in the Salary Schedule for General Schedule employees (CR-79-2008).

The fiscal impact on the County will not be negative since the affected employees will remain at their present grade

and salary levels.
