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**REPORT:** Favorable 10-0: Council Members Turner, Anderson-Walker, Davis, Dernoga, Glaros, Harrison, Hawkins, Ivey, Streeter and Taveras

CR-044-2020 seeks to amend the FY'21 School Facilities Surcharge for inflation based upon the change in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers (CPI-U). Based on the April 2019 to April 2020 date the change reflects a 0.3 increase. This change will require a \$9,770 increase in the developed tier and a \$16,698 in other areas for FY'21. This amounts to an increase of \$29 and \$50.00 respectively.

It was pointed out by Stanley Earley, Director Office of Management and Budget that this is largely a ministerial act which must be done each year.

The Office of Law reports CR-044-2020 to be in proper legal form with no impediments to its adoption.

The Policy Group reports that CR-044-2020 may increase the amount of funds available to offset the debt cost for school construction.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council sitting as the Committee of the Whole voted CR-044-2020 out favorable, 10-0
