BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Board of Appeals

3 For the purpose of temporarily expanding the composition of the Board of Appeals for Prince
4 George's County.

5 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

6 SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.

7 Section 2-119,

8 The Prince George's County Code

9 (2019 Edition; 2020 Supplement).

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
11 Maryland, that Section 2-119 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
12 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

13 **SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.**

14 **DIVISION 4. BOARD OF APPEALS.**

15 **Sec. 2-119. Board composition; terms; compensation; officers.**

16 (a) The Board of Appeals shall consist of [three (3)] five (5) members until December 31,
17 2022, appointed by the Council for a term of four (4) years or until their successors are
18 appointed and duly qualified. The term of appointments shall coincide with the term of
19 office of the Council.

20 (1) Two additional new appointees to the Board of Appeals shall serve their

1 terms until December 3, 2023.

2 (2) Current members of the Board of Appeals shall serve their terms until
3 December 31, 2022, or until their successors are appointed and confirmed.

4 (3) In the event a member currently serving on the board is replaced, the new
5 appointment will specify their terms expiration date to either December 31,
6 2022 or December 3, 2023.

7 (b) The members of the Board of Appeals shall be compensated at the rate of Seven
8 Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) per month. The Chairman thereof shall be
9 compensated an additional One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) per year
10 for administrative responsibilities.

11 (c) The Council shall designate the Chairman and the Vice-Chairman of the Board of
12 Appeals.

13 * * * * *

14 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby
15 declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,
16 sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of
17 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining
18 words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this
19 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such
20 invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,
21 or section.

22 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act be abrogated and of no further
23 force and effect after December 3, 2023.

24 SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
25 calendar days after it becomes law.
