18	(1) <u>Board and Commission members appointed under this section shall not receive</u>				
19	compensation for service on any Board or Commission unless compensation is expressly				
20	authorized for all Board or Commission members subject to Sec.2-390 of this Division.				
21	(2) <u>Board and Commission members appointed under this section shall be entitled to</u>				
22	compensation commensurate with that provided to existing members of the respective Board or				
23	Commission if:				
24	(A) The member is between the ages of twenty-one (21) and				
25	twenty-four (24); and				
26	(B) The member is appointed to a Board and Commission that				
27	authorizes compensation for its members.				
28	(3) <u>Board and Commission members appointed under this section who are twenty</u>				
29	(20) years of age or younger at the time of appointment shall receive compensation in the form				
30	of a scholarship, disbursed upon successful completion of their service term. The Scholarship				
31	amount shall be equivalent to the total remuneration accrued by the sitting members of the Board

or Commission during a full term.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
