RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Largo Town Center Development Board

For the purpose of establishing a Largo Town Center Development Board to implement land use and policy recommendations for the development of land within the 2013 Largo Town Center Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment area, including a new regional medical campus as a major public health institution.

WHEREAS, the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that portion of the Maryland Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, approved the 2013 Largo Town Center Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment on November 12, 2013, by adoption of CR-137-2013 and CR-138-2013, thereby defining long-range land use development policies and adopting detailed zoning proposals for the Largo Town Center area, generally defined as the properties bounded by the Capital Beltway (I-95/I-495) to the west, Landover Road (MD 202) and the southwest boundary of the Woodview Village subdivision to the north, Campus Way North, Lake Arbor Way, and Landover Road (MD 202) to the east, and Central Avenue (MD 214) to the south; and

WHEREAS, a critical component in achieving the core vision of the Largo Town Center Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment is its plan for implementation; and

WHEREAS, the County Council has determined that a multi-agency, public-private partnership is needed to undertake an in-depth assessment of all recommendations in the plan, evaluate existing conditions, and recommend a strategic implementation plan that maximizes development potential within the Largo Town Center plan area, builds consensus of vision in the

community, and provides procedural certainty of process; and

WHEREAS, Section 506 of the County Charter provides that the County Council may appoint, for designated periods, temporary advisory boards of citizens of the County who shall assist in the consideration of County policies and programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Largo Town Center Development Board is hereby established.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Development Board shall be comprised of fifteen (15) members as follows: a representative from the County Council or designee; a designee from the sixth councilmanic district, a representative from the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission-Prince George's County Planning Department; a representative from the Office of the County Executive; a representative from the Prince George's Economic Development Corporation; a representative from the Revenue Authority; a representative from The University of Maryland Medical System; two (2) representatives from the local business, real estate or development community; three (3) citizens residing within the Largo Town Center Sector Plan area; one (1) representative from the general public; one (1) representative from the local healthcare industry; and one (1) representative from Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following agencies and entities shall be requested to participate: Office of Law, Prince George's Redevelopment Authority, Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement, Department of Public Works and Transportation; Health Department and such other agencies and entities as may be deemed appropriate by the County Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chair of the County Council shall appoint the Chair of the Development Board from amongst the thirteen members.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Development Board shall conduct regular meetings to evaluate current development conditions, projected economic forecasts, and any other local or business considerations that are necessary to expedite the Largo Town Center Sector Plan that maximizes development potential within the Largo Town Center Plan area, builds consensus around the vision in the community, and provides procedural certainty of process.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Development Board shall submit quarterly status reports to the County Council and the County Executive commencing on or about September 15, 2014.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council Administrator, the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC)-Prince George's County Planning Department and Prince George's County Economic Development Corporation shall provide appropriate staff support for the Development Board in its work with coordination and preparation of the final report led by the M-NCPPC Prince George's County Planning Department.
