



COVID 19 Tests Ordered per Week




COVID 19 Test Results % Total: Weekly

- 8 of 37 beds in use are isolation beds (including temporary conversions)
- 35,307 visit ED (2019)
- 4 ORs
- Imaging
- Helipad
- Professional Office Building


- ED is very busy with 35,307 annual visits in 2019 with 14 ٠ positions
 - 2,400+ visits/position
 - ED benchmark: 1,600-1,800 visits/position
 - ED Admission/Transfer rate •
 - 4.8% admitted •

- 3.1% transferred for admission
- Note: would generally expect to see more beds in a hospital with an ED of this size, so • expect high transfer rate



FORT WASHINGTON BED NEED

- COVID Projection models are rapidly evolving; preliminarily 42 - 240 additional beds may be needed to address incoming COVID19 cases
- ICU capacity is the first priority
- In addition, more beds may be needed in early phase if transfers to other hospitals are not accepted
 - In 2019, 1,112 patients were transferred to other facilities, with approximately half of those transferred for higher level of care

ON-SITE TENT AND MODULAR ADDITIONS

- Phase 1: Add 1 10-Bed Med/Surg tent
 - Convert existing M/S beds in hospital to ICU/Isolation
- Phase 2: Add 1-2 Additional 10-bed Med/Surg tents as needed
- Phase 2 Option: Add 8 16 bed modular ICU
 - Avoid site planned for hospital expansion if long-term use is expected
