#### (b) <u>First Reading of Bills (Presentation)</u>

<u>CB-31-2008 – AN ACT CONCERNING BUILDING CODE</u> for the purpose of amending the Prince George's County Building ordinance, adopting certain amendments to the 2003 Edition of the International Building Code and the International Residential Code for One and Two Family Dwellings, amending sections of the Grading, Drainage and Pollution Control ordinance and generally related to grading, drainage and building standards.

Council Bill 31 was presented by Chairman at the request of the County Executive and referred to the Transportation, Housing and the Environment (THE) Committee.

<u>CB-32-2008 – AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING RESIDENTIAL ZONES</u> for the purpose of defining a Public Benefit Conservation Subdivision, permitting this use in the R-R Zone and establishing bulk regulations. - <u>PRESENTED</u>

<u>CB-33-2008 – AN ACT CONCERNING SUBDIVISIONS</u> for the purpose of establishing requirements, procedures and standards for Public Benefit Conservation Subdivisions and amending certain provisions for conservation subdivisions. - <u>PRESENTED</u>
