William Hunt, Deputy Council Administrator, provided introductory remarks and spoke to the timing of the proposal. Dr. Kevin Maxwell spoke to the proposal and an effort to work with the Council on a timely transmital to the Interagency Committee on State School Construction. Lucian Coleman, Capital Fiscal Analyst, facilitated a PowerPoint presentation which focused on on-going and completed projects, key planning accomplishments, Educational Facilities Master Plan, Modernization/Replacement Projects, Systemic Projects, New Schools and Renovations, Maintenance Plan Strategy, Requests for County Funding, Transportation, Critical Needs, Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Funding Request for Fiscal Year 2018 and next steps. Leroy Maddox, Legislative Officer, spoke to the three funding priority tiers included in the letter. The panel guests responded to questions posed by the Council regarding: CIP funding request, timing of approval process, correlation to video lottery terminal local impact funding, description of High Point high school project, bus lot repairs, alternative construction methods, bond terms, impact of under-enrollment on funding,

lead contamination, and the State task force recommendations.
