**RESOLUTION**

A RESOLUTION concerning

Gateway Roads

For the purpose of designating a portion of Suitland Road as a Gateway Road.

WHEREAS, certain arterial roadways exist that carry high volumes of traffic into and through the County; and,

WHEREAS, certain roadways are significant gateways into the County centers of business and Federal, State and local government activities; and,

WHEREAS, by adoption of CR-15-1996, the County Council designated Maryland Routes 4, 5, 214, 210 and its service roadway, 202, and 3/301 as Gateway Roads; and ,

WHEREAS, Suitland Road between Andrews Air Force Base and Suitland Parkway is a major route for traffic proceeding through the County to a significant Federal center;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the section of Suitland Road between Andrews Air Force Base and Suitland Parkway shall be designated a Gateway Road.
