BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This resolution calls on the National Traffic Safety Administration to use its authority to institute an immediate recall of unsafe Hyundais and Kias vehicles manufactured between 2011 and 2022 and to cease insurance companies from discriminating against policy holders of these vehicles. These cars were not properly installed with immobilizers, an anti-theft device. In, addition, this proposed legislation calls upon the Prince George's House and Senate Delegations of the Maryland General Assembly encouraging them to issue a recall.
