COMMITTEE VOTE: FAVORABLE 5-0 (In Favor: Council Members Exum, Harrison, Campos, Dean and Turner)

This resolution will provide uniformity and consistency in the language and style of dedication plaques that are placed on County facilities and buildings.

The dedication plaques will have a minimum size of 24" x 30", with leather texture, a single line border, and artistic bronze rendering.

The Office of Law has reviewed this legislation and finds it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

There will be no negative fiscal impact with the adoption of CR-81-2010.
