For the purpose of establishing spending control limits on the Fiscal Year 2026 Water and Sewer				
Operating and Capital Budgets of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC).				
WHEREAS, during the Fiscal Year 1994 Bi-County budget process the Montgomery and				
Prince George's C	County Councils established a Bi-County Working Group to recommend			
changes that would control the growth of debt and maintain future rate increases at WSSC close				
to the level of inflation; and				
WHEREAS, the Working Group's January 1994 Report recommended the establishment of				
a spending affordability process; and				
WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council endorsed the entire Working Group's				
report through the adoption of CR-12-1994 and the Montgomery County Council endorsed part				
of the report's recommendations through Resolution #12-1558; and				
WHEREAS	, the Councils jointly endorsed in concept the January 1994 Working Group			
Report spending affordability process; and				
WHEREAS	, both Councils endorsed the utilization of the spending affordability process			
beginning with the formulation of the Fiscal Year 1996 budget; and				
WHEREAS	WHEREAS, the Spending Affordability Working Group, consisting of the staffs of the			
Montgomery and Prince George's County Councils and both County Executive's offices, make				
certain recommendations on the WSSC Fiscal Year 2026 Operating and Capital Budgets; and				

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council and the Montgomery County Council

2	percentage of water and sewer increase; new debt; debt service and operating expenditures; and
