A RESOLUTIO	N concerning	
	Video Lottery Terminal Facilities	
For the purpose of expressing support for conditioning the approval of any location of video		
lottery terminal facilities in Prince George's County on the preference designated by a majority		
of County voters in a statewide referendum on video lottery terminal facilities.		
WHEREAS, Chapter 5 of the Laws of Maryland (2007 Special Session) proposed an		
amendment to th	e Maryland Constitution to authorize potential locations in the State for Video	
Lottery Facilities	s; and	
WHEREAS, as required by law, Chapter 5 of the Laws of Maryland (2007 Special Session)		
was referred to a referendum of the qualified voters of the State of Maryland at the November		
2008 General Ele	ection; and	
WHEREAS, a majority of the qualified voters of the State approved five (5) potential		
locations statewide for video lottery terminal facilities defined with specificity within Anne		
Arundel, Cecil, Worcester and Allegany Counties, as well as the City of Baltimore pursuant to		
the terms of Chapter 5 of the Laws of Maryland (2007 Special Session); and		
WHEREAS, no potential location for Video Lottery Facilities within Prince George's		
County was proposed in Chapter 5 of the Laws of Maryland (2007 Special Session) at the		
November 2008 General Election, nor was such potential location approved by the voters at the		
November 2008	General Election; and	
WHEREAS, the ratified provisions of the Maryland Constitution expressly require further		
State legislative enactment and subsequent referenda to authorize additional forms or expansions		
of commercial gaming in the State; and		

WHEREAS, any location of video lottery terminal facilities in Prince George's County is strictly conditioned upon successful consideration of an amendment to the Maryland Constitution enacted by the General Assembly and approved by the statewide electorate; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the County Council to determine the popular position of the voters of Prince George's County concerning the potential location of video lottery terminal facilities within the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the County Council urges the State Legislature to condition the authorization of any video lottery terminal facilities in Prince George's County on the approval by a majority of Prince George's County voters as a part of a statewide referendum of an amendment to the Maryland Constitution on additional video lottery terminal facilities, if such a statewide referendum is proposed by the State Legislature.
