RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning
2 Food Truck Hub Operations at Maryland National Capital Park and Planning Commission
3 Facilities

4 For the purpose of encouraging the operation of food trucks at all Maryland National Capital
5 Park and Planning Commission Facilities.

6 WHEREAS, Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (“Commission”)
7 has the ability to have food trucks operate at its facilities in Prince George’s County; and

8 WHEREAS, Prince George’s County wants to encourage the lawful operation of food
9 trucks at Commission facilities in Prince George’s County; and

10 WHEREAS, the Department of Permitting, Inspection and Enforcement (“DPIE”) requires
11 information about the date, time and place that food trucks are vending food at locations in the
12 County so that it may perform necessary on-site inspections of food trucks; and

13 WHEREAS, the Commission desires to cooperate with DPIE concerning food trucks that
14 operate on Commission property

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
16 County, Maryland, that DPIE will enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the
17 Commission to establish mechanisms for food trucks that operate on Commission property.
